- Sun and Moon Twin Pagodas (????(????))(without climbing the towers) The Sun and Moon Towers, also known as the Golden Tower and Silver Tower, emit golden and silver lights respectively at night, creating a stunning reflection in the lake, making the scene especially beautiful. Check in to the Guilin hotel.

Day 2 :- Guilin - Yangshuo

After breakfast at hotel, proceed to:

- Reed Flute Cave (?????)Is a famous limestone cave located in Guilin, China, known for its stunning stalactites, stalagmites, and rock formations illuminated by colorful lights.
- Drive Through the Ten-Mile Gallery (?????) is a picturesque scenic area in Yangshuo, Guilin, China. This stunning route is renowned for its breathtaking karst mountains, lush countryside, and charming rural landscapes, resembling a traditional Chinese landscape painting.
- Moon Hill (Exterior View)(???) is a hill with a natural arch through it a few kilometers outside Yangshuo in southern China's Guangxi autonomous region.
- West Street, Yangshuo (????) is the oldest and most famous street in Yangshuo, Guilin, China. With a history of over 1,400 years, it is a vibrant and culturally rich area known for its mix of traditional Chinese architecture and Western influences.
- Experience the High Mountain and Flowing Water Welcome Banquet + Bonfire Party (????????+????) Check in to the Yangshuo hotel.

- Sitang Township (????), located in Lingui District, Guilin, Guangxi, is an area rich in cultural heritage and natural beauty. A notable highlight is Tianxin Village, an ancient settlement that exemplifies traditional Chinese rural life.
- Jieyuan Archway (???) is a historical monument that symbolizes academic excellence in ancient China. The term “Jieyuan” refers to the top scholar in the provincial-level imperial examination during the imperial era. Check in to the Guilin hotel.

- Tashan Mountain (??), located in the southern suburbs of Guilin, Guangxi, China, is a prominent feature within Chuanshan Park. Standing at an altitude of 194 meters, it offers visitors picturesque landscapes and historical sites.
- Chuanshan Cave (Eye of Landscape)(????(????)) is a famous karst cave located in Chuanshan Park, Guilin, China. Known for its spectacular stalactites, stalagmites, and underground rivers, the cave is often referred to as the “Eye of Landscape” because of its stunning natural formations and unique lighting effects.
- Xishan Park (Includes Complimentary Afternoon Tea Break) (????)(?????) is a scenic park located in Guilin, China, known for its serene landscapes, ancient Buddhist culture, and karst mountain formations.
- Osmanthus Commune (????) is a cultural and tourism complex located at 18 Yangjiang Road, Xiufeng District, Guilin, China.
