Day 2 :- Tashkent

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 5 :- Bishkek – Ala Archa – Bishkek

Visit petroglyphs dating back to 800 B.C. before continuing along the northern shore to Karakol. Explore the Dungan Mosque, built in Chinese style without nails, and an old wooden Orthodox Church. Overnight in Karakol.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 8 :- Karakol – Jeti Oguz – Bokonbaevo

Drive to Jeti Oguz Gorge, famous for its red rock formations, including Seven Bulls and Broken Heart Mountain. Enjoy panoramic views before continuing to Bokonbaevo, where you can experience local Kyrgyz nomadic culture. Overnight at a guesthouse.

Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Day 9 :- Bokonbaevo – Bishkek – Almaty (Local Flight)

Transfer back to Bishkek for a flight to Almaty, Kazakhstan. Upon arrival, check in and enjoy free time to explore the city. Overnight in Almaty.

Day 10 :- Almaty City Tour

Visit the bustling Green Bazaar, Panfilov Park, and Zenkov Cathedral, one of the world's tallest wooden buildings. Take a scenic drive to the Shymbulak ski resort before visiting a falcon farm to learn about traditional Kazakh eagle hunting. Overnight in Almaty.

Day 11 :- Almaty – Charyn Canyon – Almaty

Take a day trip to Charyn Canyon, a breathtaking natural wonder with towering rock formations shaped over millions of years. Walk through the Valley of Castles and enjoy the stunning landscapes before returning to Almaty. Overnight in Almaty.

Day 12 :- Almaty – Dushanbe (Local Flight)

Fly to Dushanbe, Tajikistan. Upon arrival, visit the National Museum of Antiquities, Gurminj Musical Instruments Museum, and the Haji Yakub Mosque. Overnight in Dushanbe.

Day 15 :- Samarkand City Tour

Day 17 :- Samarkand – Bukhara (Train)

Take a morning train to Bukhara and explore the Ark Citadel, Samanid Mausoleum, Chashma Ayub, Bolo- Hauz Mosque, and the lively shopping domes. Visit Nodir Divan Begi Madrasah and Poi Kalon Complex. Overnight in Bukhara.

Day 18 :- Bukhara Sightseeing

Visit the Bahaiddin Naqshbandi complex, an important Sufi pilgrimage site, and the stunning summer palace of Bukhara's emirs, Sitorai Mohi Hosa. Explore Chor Bakr necropolis before returning to the city. Overnight in Bukhara.

Day 19 :- Bukhara – Khiva

Drive through the Kyzylkum Desert, stopping for views of the Amu Darya River before arriving in Khiva. Enjoy free time to explore this well-preserved Silk Road city. Overnight in Khiva.
